Trading for a proprietary account on regulated exchanges, as related to a DMCC licence, refers to the activity of conducting trades on behalf of a company using the company's own funds (proprietorship) on exchanges that are regulated and approved by the Dubai Multi Commodities Centre (DMCC).

In this context, a proprietary account refers to a trading account owned and operated by a company or firm rather than on behalf of clients or investors. The company trades with its own capital, seeking to generate profits directly for itself rather than acting as an intermediary for others.

When a company holds a DMCC licence allowing trading for a proprietary account, it means that the company is authorised to engage in trading activities on regulated exchanges approved by the DMCC, using its own capital. This could include trading in commodities, precious metals, futures contracts, options, or other financial instruments available on those exchanges.

By obtaining this type of licence, companies can benefit from operating within a regulated environment, accessing the infrastructure and services provided by the DMCC, and conducting trading activities in compliance with the rules and regulations set forth by the DMCC and the respective regulated exchanges
